Attention: No restriction anymore !!

Participation:

- All pigeons will participate in the **international** competition.
- There will be no exception to this.
- There will be a **separate doubling of the hens: € 0,25**
- The **minimum** distance to participate is **730 km**.

Rubber rings: NEW – NEW - NEW

- Two rubber rings are compulsory: **one on each paw by using a normal clock. (no electronic clock)**
- **No rubber ring** when you clock electronic !

- **To be mentioned on the International Forms for the bets !**

Baskets:

- **Baskets:** are in good state, equipped with lead. A maximum of **18 pigeons (NEW !!)** per basket
- Baskets must be **labelled** (with **PAU**)

Following data must be visible on the labels:

- **the amount of baskets**, including those which are not completely full.
- **the number of the basket** and the name of the registration office (legible writing please).
- **The amount of the pigeons**, including **amount of male and female pigeons**, **must be written on those baskets which are not completely full.**
